



Reordering Learning Module pages


How to reorder LM pages to scroll through in a different order

Renaming pages and changing the order of your Learning Module Pages

Why reorder pages?

Using learning module page navigation and the toolbar arrows   a user scrolls through learning module pages in the order that they appear in their folder listing. Any new pages are automatically placed at the bottom of the list so are therefore the last page a user will see if using the page navigation or toolbar arrows. For this reason pages may need to be reordered.

How to reorder pages

1. Open one of the learning module pages.
2. From the Digitalbrain toolbar click View and  Folder listing.

3. To the right of the page click on the up and down arrows to the right of the list. The page will now move up or down by one page, continue clicking until you are happy with its position.
